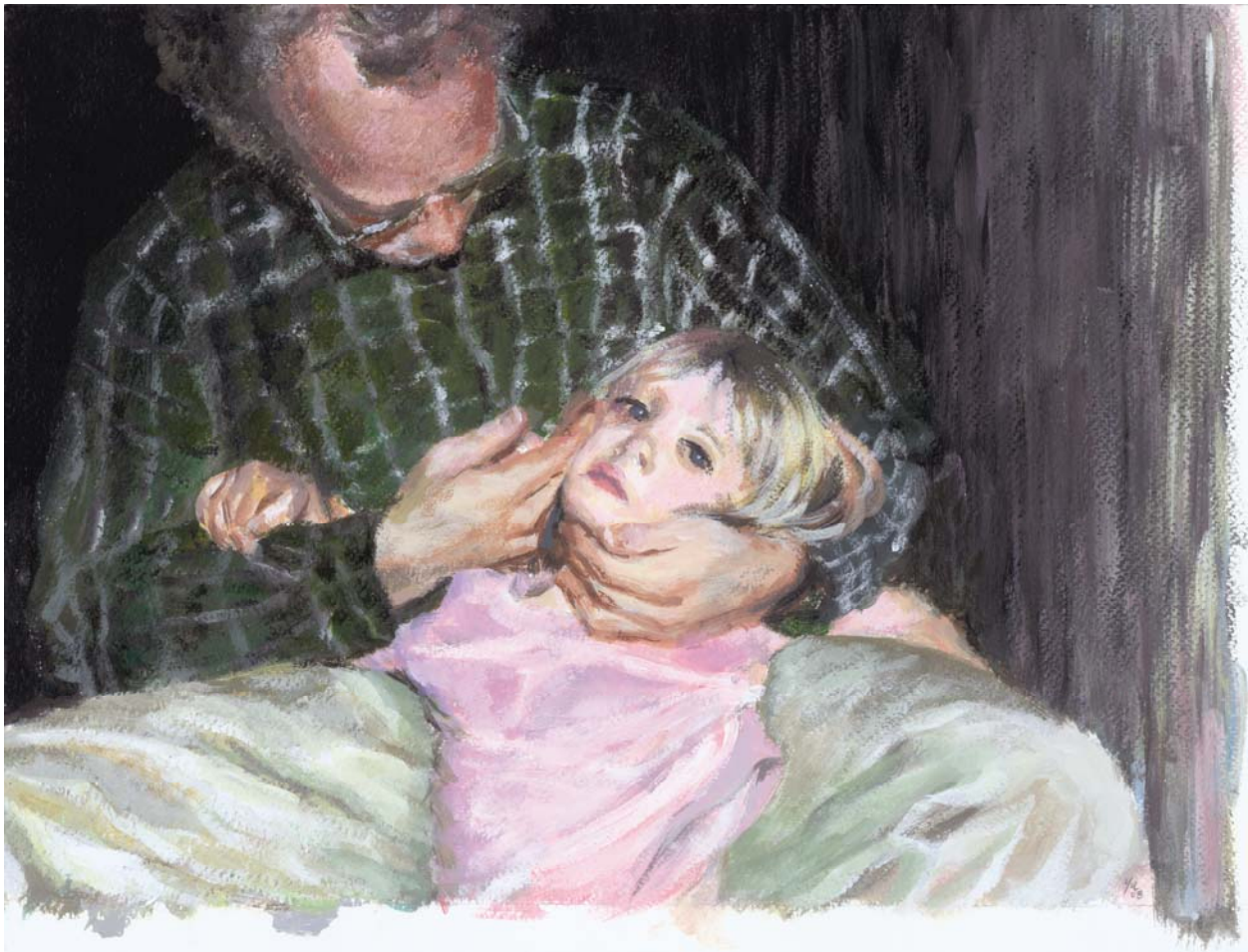
The 2008 theme of the Teen Media Contest was, “*Depict how your parent supports your dreams.*” The contest was open to all New Jersey high school and middle school students.
